**Rules-**

**Street Play-**

1. There should be 10 artists in a group
2. The teams will have to bring their own costumes and instruments
3. The duration will be of 10 minutes.
4. The street play can be presented in Marathi, Hindi or English
5. Only one entry will be allowed from a college

### **Elocution Competition-**

1. Each participant will be given a period of 5 minutes
2. The speaker can express his/her views in Marathi, Hindi or English
3. Only one entry will be allowed from a college

### **Essay Competition-**

1. The length of essay should be of 3000 words
2. The Essay can be written in Marathi, Hindi or English
3. The Essay must bear the name of the student, college and mobile number.
4. Maximum two entries will be allowed from a college
