#### **ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT:**

Post Graduate Teaching Department of Law is a Department run by the Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj, Nagpur University, Nagpur and it was established in the year 1963 under the Third Five Year Plan on the basis of the recommendations of UGC. The Department was established to promote advanced training in law and research. Our University adopted a Ph.D. Ordinance which permitted registration of students for the Ph.D. Programme in Law. In the year 2016, the Choice Base Credit System (CBCS) Pattern was introduced and the present syllabus is based on the model curriculum framed by the University Grant Commission. At present, institutionalized instructions are offered in SEVEN specializations in the department which include:

- ♣ Group A - International Law
- ♣ Group B - Constitutional Law and Administrative Law
- ♣ Group C - Intellectual Property Laws
- ♣ Group D - Business Law
- ♣ Group E - Environment and Legal Order
- ♣ Group F - Labour, Capital and Law

## ♣ Group G - Criminal Law

The Department is involved in conducting various Research works in the form of Dissertation, Socio-Legal Projects, Ph.D Thesis, Major- Minor Projects etc on the contemporary legal research topics. The Department of Law is instrumental in providing assistance to Research Scholars for completing their Ph.D. in Law. The area of ongoing research work covers a very wide arena including Business Laws, Cyber Laws, Constitutional and Administrative Laws, Labour Laws, Intellectual Property Laws, Environmental Laws, International Law, International Economic Law, International Trade Law, and Criminal Law.

The object of the LL.M. studies is not merely to prepare conscientious and competent members for the profession but it is expected to advance and disseminate knowledge of law and legal processes in the context of national development. The endeavour of the Department of Law is to look at law as an instrument for social change and human well-being.
