DETAILED RULES EVENT WISE

MUSIC

1) CLASSICAL VOCAL SOLO (HINDUSTANI /KARNATAKI)

1. Only one entry per college is allowed
2. Maximum number of accompanists is two
3. Time allotted for item is not less than 8 minutes and not more than 10 minutes for each style.
4. Item can be presented in either Hindustani or Karnataki style.
5. Cinema songs are not allowed under this item.
6. Sufficient thought and care must be exercised in the choice of raga, and composition.
7. Judgments will be based on the qualities like swara tal, selection of raga composition and general impression.

2) CLASSICAL INSTRUMENTAL SOLO (PERCUSSION – SWAR VADYA)

1. Only one entry per college is allowed
2. Maximum number of accompanists is two
3. Participants must bring their own instruments.
4. Item can be presented in either Hindustani or Karnataki style.
5. Time allotted for item is not less than 8 minutes and not more than 10 minutes for each style.
6. Judgments will be based on the qualities like swara tal, selection of raga composition and general impression.

3) CLASSICAL INSTRUMENTAL SOLO (NON-PERCUSSION – SWAR VADYA)

1. Only one entry per college is allowed
2. Maximum number of accompanists is two
3. Participants must bring their own instruments.
4. Instruments of Western origin adopted to the Indian raga system are allowed.
5. Item can be presented in either Hindustani or Karnataki style.
6. Time allotted for item is not less than 8 minutes and not more than 10 minutes for each style.
7. Judgments will be based on the qualities like swara tal, selection of raga composition and general impression.

4) GROUP SONG (INDIAN)

1. Only one team per College/Institute/University Department is allowed
2. Two group songs will be presented by the same team out of which one will be a folk song and the other patriotic.
3. Maximum number of singers in a group can be six Maximum numbers of accompanists playing instruments shall be three.
4. The group songs should be taken from Indian songs which can be of any regional language.
5. No film song should be presented as group songs.
6. Maximum Time allotted for the group song is 10 minutes which does not include setting time. The setting time for a group shall not exceed 4 minutes.
7. Judgments of this item will be on the basis of quality of singing only and not on make up costumes and action of the team.

5) WESTERN VOCAL SOLO:

1. Only one entry per College/Institute/University Department is allowed.
2. Time for Stage/ Instruments setting is maximum 2 minutes.
3. The number of accompanists would not be more than two.
4. Duration of the song shall be between 4 to 6 minutes.

5. Language of the song shall only be English.
6. Judgment will be made on the qualities like, composition, rhythm, coordination and general impression.

6) GROUP SONGS (WESTERN):

1. Only one entry per College/Institute/University Department is allowed
2. Maximum 6 singers in a group, maximum 3 number of accompanists playing instruments are allowed.
3. The group song should be taken from English language.
4. Maximum time allowed for the group song is 10 minutes which does not include setting time. The setting time shall not exceed 5 minutes.
5. Judging of this item will be on the basis of quality of singing only and not on makeup, costumes and actions of the team.

7) FOLK ORCHESTRA:

1. Each College can send only one team.
2. The team shall consist of up to 12 participants.
3. The group can consist of all boys or all girls or combined.
4. The duration of the performance will be a minimum for 7 and a maximum for 10 minutes.
5. This does not include setting time which shall not be more than 5 minutes.
6. Up to three professional accompanists are allowed who should be in different dress from the student participants so that they could be easily identified.
7. The professional accompanists shall sit stand separately from the Participants and shall not lead the team.
8. The team may present preferably those folk tunes which are recognized as folk tunes of the state to which the university belongs.

DANCE :

1) FOLK / TRIBAL DANCE (INDIAN)

1. Maximum number of accompanists permissible is five.
2. The team may consist of all boys, all girls or a combination of both
3. The dance can be either primitive or a folk dance (Indian style) but not a classical one or film dance.
4. Duration of the dance should not be more than 10 minutes.
5. Three copies of a brief note giving the theme and text of the song if any is to be submitted along with the entry form at the time of registration.
6. The participating team will be responsible for clearing the stage.
7. Judgments will be based on the rhythm, formation, expression, makeup, sets and overall effect.

2) CLASSICAL DANCE (INDIAN)

1. Each college can send only one entry.
2. The classical dance can be from any of the approved schools of dance such as Kathak, Kathakali) Bharat Nattyam, Manipuri, Kuchipudi, Mohiniyattam and Odissi.
3. Each participant will be allowed up to 13 minutes including time for preparation, exit etc.
4. Judgment will be based basically on the qualities like tal and technique rhythm abhinays of expression, costume, footwork and general impression etc.
5. Maximum three accompanists are permissible.
6. Three copies of brief note on the description of dance story involved in it if any and on the accompanying send if any with its meaning in his or English must be submitted at the time of registration. Three copies of the theme of the dance in short to be submitted in English, Hindi or Marathi at the time or registration.
7. No film dance is allowed.

LITERARY EVENTS:

QUIZ:

1. Each college can send a team of three persons. .
2. There will be a written preliminary round and 4 teams will be selected for the final.
3. The final will be oral ~with audio-visual questions also.
4. The specific rules regarding evaluation procedure time to read a particular answer and the type of round will be given before actual start of the competition.

DEBATE:

1. The Topic of debate is
2. Each college can send only one team of two students one for the motion and another against it.
3. The contest is open in English, Hindi and Marathi language only.
4. Each speaker shall be given Five Minutes.

ELOCUTION:

1. Each college can send only one team of two students one for the motion and another against it.
2. The contest is open in English, Hindi and Marathi language only.
3. Each speaker shall be given Ten Minutes.

POETRY RECITATION :

1. Each college can send only one team of two students one for the motion and another against it.
2. The contest is open in English, Hindi and Marathi language only.
3. Each speaker shall be given Five Minutes.

THEATRE

ONE ACT PLAY:

- (a) Maximum time is of 30 minutes.
- (b) Total participants shall not exceed eight students.
- (c) Participants shall bring their own props for play.
- (d) Theme of play should not be against any person, caste and religion.

SKIT:

1. Only one team per College/Institute/University Department is allowed.
2. Maximum number of six participants are allowed to participate in the item.
3. Maximum time allotted for each team is 10 minutes.
4. Use of makeup, drapery and background music is allowed.
5. No personal remarks against persons, character assassination etc. is allowed.
6. Participating team should give three copies of names of the participants along with language of presentation on the day of registration.

MIME:

1. Only one entry per College/Institute/University Department is allowed will be entertained.
2. Maximum number of six participants is allowed to participate in the team.
3. Maximum time allotted for each team is 5 minutes.

4. Judgment will most likely be based on qualities like idea, creativity of presentation such as make-up, costumes and general impression.

MIMICRY:

1. Only one entry per college will be entertained.
2. Maximum Single participant is allowed to participate in the team.
3. Maximum time allotted for each team is 4 minutes.

FINE ARTS:

ON THE SPOT PAINTING

1. Item will be conducted on the spot and the participants will be requested to do painting on the subject given by the discharges of the competition.
4. Duration will be not more than one hour.
5. Size of the painting will be half imperial size drawing paper i.e. 22 inches by 15 inches.
6. Painting can be: done in oil water poster or pasted color.
7. Candidates will be bringing their material like brushes paper sheets.

COLLAGE:

1. Each college will be represented by one participant.
2. Item will be conducted on the spot.
3. Duration will not be more than one hour.
4. Participants are requested to bring their own scissors, collage material and other required items.

POSTER MAKING:

1. Each College will be represented by one participant
2. Item will be conducted on the spot and the participants will be requested to do poster making on the subject given.
3. Duration will not be more than one hour.
4. Candidates will bring their own material like brushes, colors, sheets etc.

CLAY MODELLING:

1. Each college will be represented by one participant
2. Item will be conducted on the spot.
3. Duration will not be more than one hour.
4. Candidates should bring their own clay for the selection trials.

CARTOONING:

1. Each college will be represented by one participant.
2. Item will be conducted on the spot on the given subject.
3. Duration will not more than one hour.

RANGOLI:

1. This art is known differently in various regions like Mandna, alpna alekhan, Kalam, Rangoli etc.
2. Each college can send only one student.
3. The medium & Form for expression could be free hand pictorial
4. The time allotted shall not exceed one hour.
5. The participant should bring their required material for Rangoli
