Sub: Grant of PG Scholarship to full time GATE/GPAT qualified students admitted in M.E/M.Tech/M.Pharm/M.Arch courses with AICTE approved Institutions/University Departments-reg.

Sir,

Vide MHRD letter number F.1-24/2013-TS-II dated 14.10.2015 dated it has been informed that as per definition mentioned in Para 2(h) of AICTE Act, Deemed/Pvt. University are not "Technical Institutions". PG courses of Deemed and Pvt. Universities are affiliated only for the purpose of getting benefit of PG Scholarship, However, UG courses of Deemed/Pvt. Universities are not affiliated from AICTE. Some of the centrally funded Institutions are also getting their PG courses approval by the AICTE only for the purpose of PG Scholarship.

In view of the above MHRD has clarified that "AICTE shall extend Scheme of PG Scholarship to Technical Institutions, not being a University, which offers courses or programmes of Technical educations only. CFTIs/CFIs are supported by their plan fund allocated from MHRD. Private/Deemed Universities are supported by UGC." The change in policy of PG Scholarship is effective from academic year 2016-17.

A notification in this regard was issued by AICTE vide letter number F.75/RIFD/DBT/Misc./2013-14/Part file dated 1.12.2015. The copy of the notification dated 1.12.2015 was up-loaded on the portal of AICTE for the ready reference of concerned Institutions/University Departments. All the Universities which were earlier in receipt of PG Scholarship in respect of students admitted PG Courses are once again requested to take a note that from the academic year 2016-17, PG Scholarship will be released to only those Intuitions which are covered/eligible under the ambit of new policy. University may approach the concerned regulatory authority as per the revised policy for grant of PG Scholarship to the students admitted in various departments of the University.
